About the Book

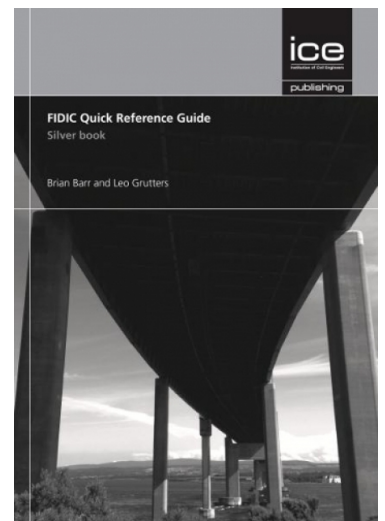
