### About the Book

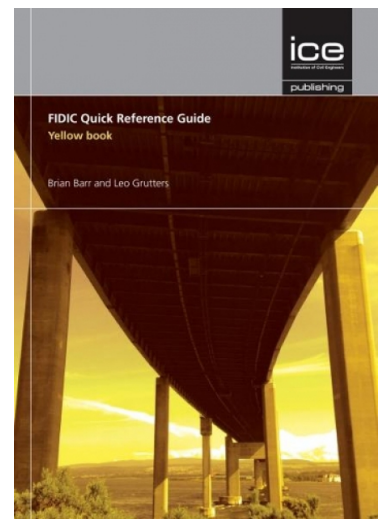
